Summer Term - 2016

This term in nursery, we will be focussing on friendship and how to make friends who are far away.

We have begun the term by making a booklet all about ourselves. This booklet will include a range of work; the children will draw pictures of themselves, write sentences about what they like and dislike and put together a collage of baby photos. The children will also be talking about what they want to be when they are older, and completing a creative activity based around this. Once the booklets are complete, the children will send some of the work to their new far away friends, so they can get to know each other better.



An important focus of the Summer term is introducing the children to their new Reception class, ready for the transition in September. We will be increasingly encouraging the children to go through into the Reception classes, so they can become used to the environment and the new teachers, before the end of this year. We will initially be taking small groups to spend time in Reception, leading up to everybody in the class feeling confident enough to be in Reception without any Nursery staff present.

At the end of the summer term we have a very exciting event; all the children in both morning and afternoon nursery will come together for a fun disco! The disco is a fantastic way for the children in the separate nursery classes to meet each other and make lots of new friends, ready for September. It will be a great way of celebrating the end of the year and the children's' time in nursery.
