#### <u>Writing</u>

This term we will be focusing on and creating our blogs, explanation texts and stories with familiar settings. We are continuing to focus on sentence structure and trying to include a range of vocabulary and punctuation.

#### <u>Maths</u>

In Maths we will be looking carefully at and revising calculation methods for + - x and ÷.

Our Nicer Challenge Pack this term is **The Really Rural Show**.

Our Challenge is to 'bring the countryside to Victoria Park'. We will be focusing on the countryside, including growing and creating our own country style show.

In science children will be learning about Living things and their habitats as well as Plants.
