Focus in prime areas

<u>Communication and language</u> - beginning to talk in complex sentences about what they are doing. Listening and understanding different instructions. Using different tenses in our sentences

<u>Physical development</u> - caring for own needs and developing a dominant hand to begin to write recognisable letters.

<u>Personal, social and emotional needs -</u> tolerating change in routines and negotiating with friends.

Focus in specific areas.

<u>Literacy -</u> giving meaning to our different mark making. Describing a main theme in a story that we have listened to. Hearing sounds in words and beginning to write letters.

<u>Mathematics</u> - Beginning to count sets of objects with accuracy. Using the language of shape and size. Comparing groups of objects. Using the language of more and less.

<u>Expressive arts and design -</u> singing a range of familiar songs, exploring different media expressing preferences. Using tools for a purpose.

<u>Understanding the world</u>—talking about themselves and family. Looking at their environment, changes and how things work. Using technology to support learning.
