All staff in Nursery would like to say a big welcome back to all the children and parents after the holidays. We hope the weather will be kind to us this term, so that we can continue to take our learning outside. Please remember to put a coat on your child each day so that they can choose to engage in their learning both indoors and outdoors.

#### Focus in prime areas

<u>Communication and language</u> - beginning to talk in complex sentences about what they are doing. Listening and understanding different instructions.

<u>Physical development</u> - caring for own needs and developing their gross and fine motor skills.

<u>Personal, social and emotional needs -</u> having own likes and dislikes. Caring for others and having special friends in school.

## Focus in specific areas.

<u>Literacy -</u> giving meaning to our different mark making. Talking about why we like a book of choice. Recognising our names and other familiar print.

<u>Mathematics</u> - Beginning to recognise numerals and matching to amounts. Using the language of shape and size. Comparing groups of objects.

<u>Expressive arts and design -</u> singing a range of familiar songs, exploring different media e.g. paint, dance, and gloop with a specific purpose.

<u>Understanding the world</u>—talking about themselves and family. Looking at their environment, changes and how things work. Using technology to enhance our learning.
