### Focus in Maths

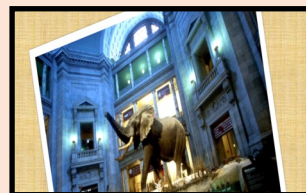
**Key skills to be taught:** Shape, Money, Fractions and Measurement. We are aiming to link these to our NICER Challenge pack.
