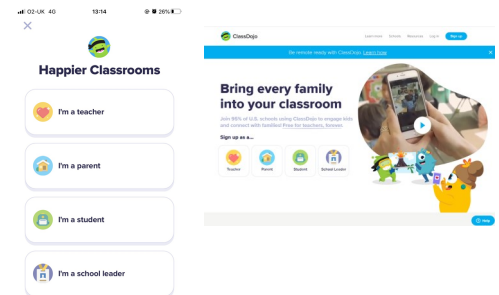
What is ClassDojo?

ClassDojo is an interactive reward system that allows you to see what and how well your child is doing at school. ClassDojo can translate posts and messages in over 40+ languages.

You can use Class Dojo on an app for iOS and Android, and also from a computer at: www.classdojo.com

Joining ClassDojo

Your class teacher will pass on a document to you with your Invite Parents instructions.



How does my child log in at home?

iOS/android app

Once you have logged in as Parent, on the Stories page, click the top left hand corner circle. You should then see your child's name in the drop down option.

From the web

If your child is accessing Dojo from the web, they will need to ask their class teacher for the link that can only be used for your child.

How your child logs in will depend on the device you are using.

Class Story

After you have signed up, you will be able to see your child's involvement through 'Class Story'.

The Class Story is updated regularly with key information and photographs by the class teacher.

Messages

Messaging is another part of Dojo. Parents and teachers can communicate with each other very easily.

Please remember messaging through Dojo should not be used for sensitive or behavioural issues. It should also not be used to report child absence.

Awarding stickers and points

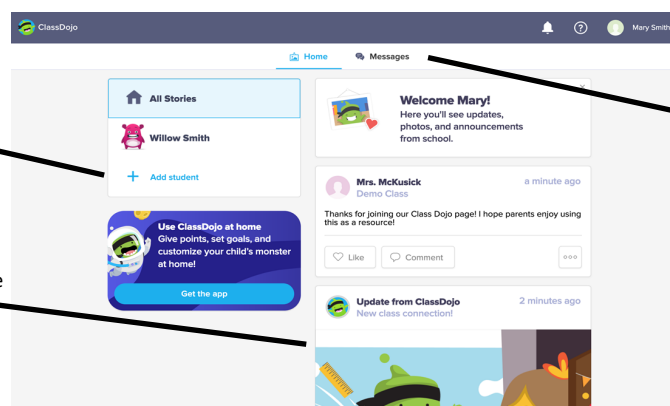
Awarding stickers and points to your child is an excellent way for teachers to reward them for completing a task: please look out for these and praise your child.
