

# Sharing your child's learning with



# ClassDojo

## INFORMATION

ClassDojo Portfolios is a 100% free, digital child portfolio that allows children to share their learning with their teacher and their family! Children can upload work to their Portfolio, and families can see their child's posts whenever they login to ClassDojo. To see your child's work, simply log into your ClassDojo parent account and tap the Stories feed to see your child's posts. You can "like" a post and leave a comment, and both your child and their teacher will be able to see your feedback!

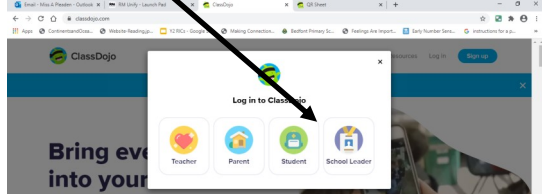
## HOW TO USE

Class teachers will be using ClassDojo Portfolios to send out the home learning sheets. These sheets will require children to respond and submit their learning.

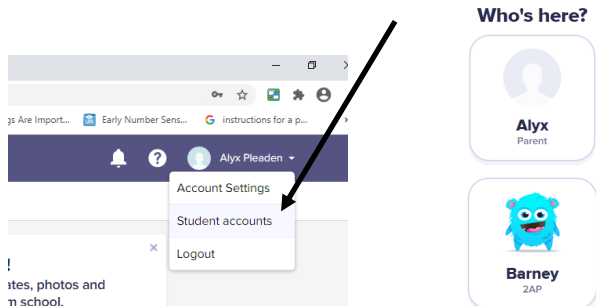
**1. In order to view the home learning activities you will first of all need to be logged into your child's account on ClassDojo.**

### On the website

Use the personal log in information that teachers sent on ClassDojo.

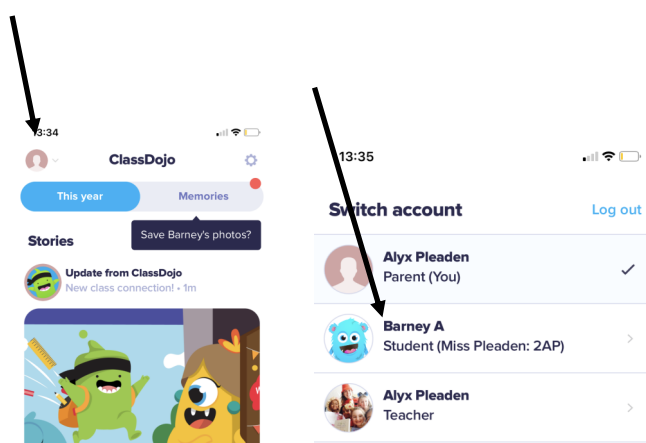


Alternatively, log in with your Parent account information.



### On the app

1. Tap on your picture on the top left hand side.
2. Tap on your child's name.



**2. When logged in as your child, they will be able to see their activities.**

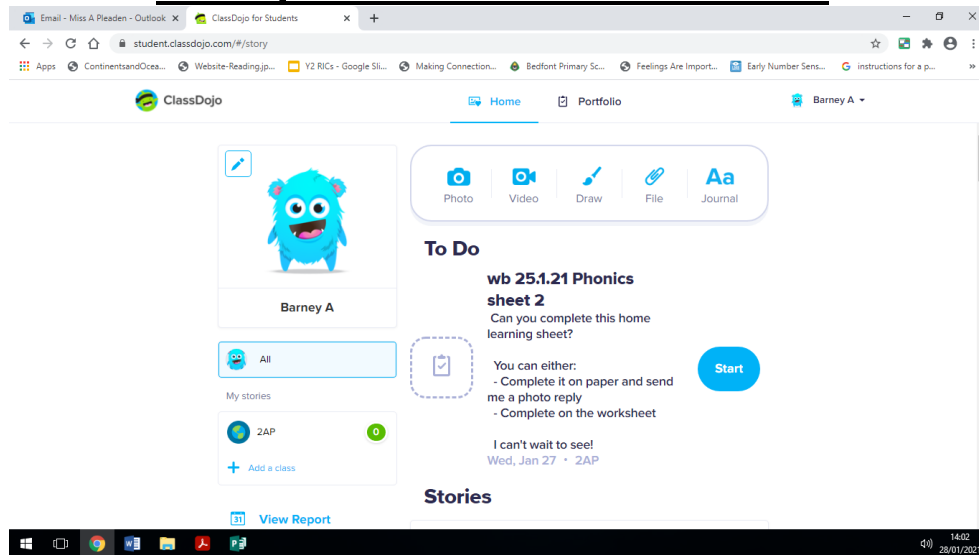
### On the website

1. You will see all of your children's home learning activities under "To Do" at the top of the 'Home' or 'Portfolio' tab.
2. Click start next to the activity you would like to begin.
3. Read the activity instructions and complete the activity.
4. Click 'Save' to finish the activity later. Click 'Hand In' to send the activity to your teacher.

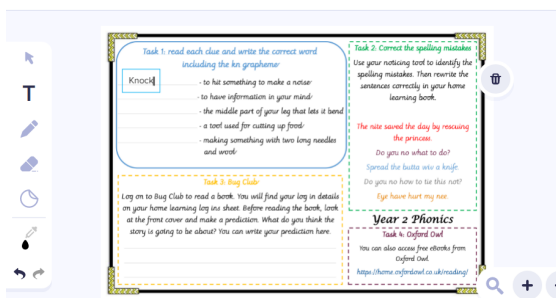
### On the app

1. Tap on the class name.
2. You will see all of your child's activities under "To Do" at the top of the screen.
3. Tap on the activity you would like to begin and then press 'Start'.
4. Click 'Done' when you are finished.
5. Click the blue downward facing arrow to finish the activity later. Click the blue paper airplane to send the activity to your teacher.

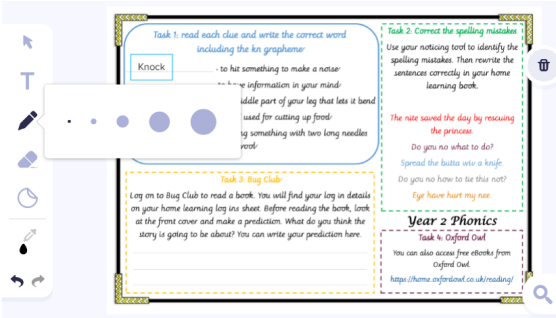
# Example of how it can be used



Children can click the T icon to type on the sheet.



Children can click the Pencil icon to write on the sheet.



As mentioned on the first page, there may be activities on the sheet that your child would prefer to complete on paper. This is absolutely fine.

Click + next to My Portfolio

Children can then press Photo and add a photo of their work.
